### **REVISING THE STATE CONSTITUTION**

Every 20 years, Florida convenes the Constitutional Revision Commission to propose changes to the State's Constitution. The Commission will be established in February-March to examine the Constitution, conduct public hearings throughout the state, and propose changes that will be on the ballot in November 2018. The Commission includes the Attorney General, 15 citizens appointed by the Governor, 9 appointed by the Speaker of the House, 9 appointed by the President of the Senate, and 3 appointed by the Chief Justice.
